Supplier capability in Vietnam

INDOOR & OUTDOOR FURNITURE

Revitalized demand from traditional export markets and growing popularity in new foreign destinations are helping propel Vietnam's indoor and outdoor furniture industry.

Weakened the year before by the global economic crisis, the sector fared positively in 2010 and continues to do so. Its short-term performance is also expected to remain strong as overseas shipments are seen to surge about 20 percent by end-2011.

The industry has a number of competitive advantages, chief of which is robust OEM capability. This is demonstrated by Global Sources findings that nearly 90 percent of turnout is produced according to customers' specifications.

The sector also enjoys easy access to various types of raw materials obtained from forests and plantations throughout the country.

Key findings

- 1. Many makers consider the rising cost of labor as the most critical concern facing the industry. Government regulations seeking to balance salary discrepancies between workers of locally owned and foreign-invested companies are pushing up outlay on manpower. In addition, adjustments to the minimum wage are frequently implemented, hindering competitiveness.
- 2. Suppliers will continue to emphasize the sector's traditional export markets, which are North America, the EU and the Asia-Pacific region. Several, however, are also putting special attention on emerging destinations abroad that have escalating demand for furniture India and the Middle East are sor of these locations,
- 3. The sector is generally split regarding price movements in coming months. One-half of featured enterprises expect quotes to increase as a result of higher production expenditure. The rest anticipates rates to remain unchanged in order to attract new buyers and sustain viability.
- 4. Upcoming releases over the next 12 months will mostly come in modern designs that feature decorative elements. These include pieces that have sections or embellishments made of natural materials such as seagrass and water hyacinth.
- 5. The industry targets the low-end and midrange segments, which are composed of models in rattan, bamboo and inexpensive types of wood. Items for the upscale market are also produced.

Objective, methodology & scope

The Developing Country Sourcing Report series is part of Global Sources' corporate social responsibility initiatives. It is offered in conjunction with The Kearny Alliance, whose mission is Aid through Trade. The objective is to help create jobs in developing Asia through export promotion.

This Vietnam Sourcing Report is part of a series designed to provide buyers with information on new products from export manufacturers in supply markets that specialize in handmade merchandise.

To produce this report, large, midsize and emerging manufacturers, all with substantial export experience, were surveyed. The selection of suppliers is designed to reflect the composition of the industry in Vietnam in terms of geographic location, materials used and range of products offered.

For in-depth profiles, our researchers

visited the facilities of each company and interviewed senior executives who discussed their recent performance and provided forecasts for the next 12 months. All other makers in this report were either visited or contacted by phone.

In each case, companies were required to answer specific questions designed to verify their manufacturing and export credentials, including a breakdown of exports by product type and market. Suppliers also participated in a survey designed to provide insight into the industry.

This report covers the main types of indoor and outdoor furniture available in Vietnam, including living room, bedroom, dining and kitchen, and garden and outdoor models. Each product category has its own price guide that describes features of low-end, midrange and highend models.

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Alpha Co. Ltd

For the past seven years, Alpha has been producing and exporting wooden furniture. Offering midrange and high-end items, the company posted sales of \$8 million in 2010.

The entire output is sent abroad, with the Asia-Pacific region accounting for four-fifths of shipments. South Korea and Japan are the biggest markets. Germany takes up 15 percent. The rest goes to the US.

Eighty percent of orders are made under OEM basis.

Living room furniture represents two-fifths of exports. The segment includes sofas, armchairs and sectionals. The supplier also manufactures bedroom and kitchen furniture.

Quotes range from \$40 to \$300, depending on the size, materials used and design complexity. Dressing stools and nightstands start at \$30 and \$50, respectively. Drawers are priced between \$170 and \$290.

Oak is imported from the EU. Rubberwood, MDF and veneer are sourced form local vendors.

Alpha employs 15 designers. As many as 10 models are created every month. Sampling time is between seven and 15 days.

All manufacturing processes are performed in a 50,000sqm factory in Binh Duong province's Tan Uyen district.

There are 650 full-time employees. Fifty additional workers are taken in when large orders are placed. The peak season is from August to November.

The QC team is composed of 20 inspectors. All finished products are examined before packing and shipping.

The company makes 7,500 pieces a month when operating at full capacity.

Cartons are normally used as packaging. The minimum order requirement is one FEU. Delivery is within 45 days.

Alpha has participated in the Vietnam International Furniture and Home Accessories Fair in Ho Chi Min
